

Faculty Appointment in Pastoral Care and Counseling at Boston College's School of Theology and Ministry (STM)

Boston College's School of Theology and Ministry (STM) seeks to appoint a tenure track assistant professor in Pastoral Care and Counseling. This appointment will be within the STM's Department of Religious Education and Pastoral Ministry (DREPM), to begin September 2012. Candidates should have a PhD in Pastoral Care and Counseling, Psychology of Religion or a closely related field. They should also possess a commitment to theological education for lay and ordained ministry, and a keen knowledge of Catholic polity and pastoral life. Candidates should be prepared to teach general introductory and specialized courses in pastoral care and counseling. The deadline for applications is March 1st, 2012, though the position will remain open until filled.
